Employer's bank account is debited based on employee utilization (no imprest balance)



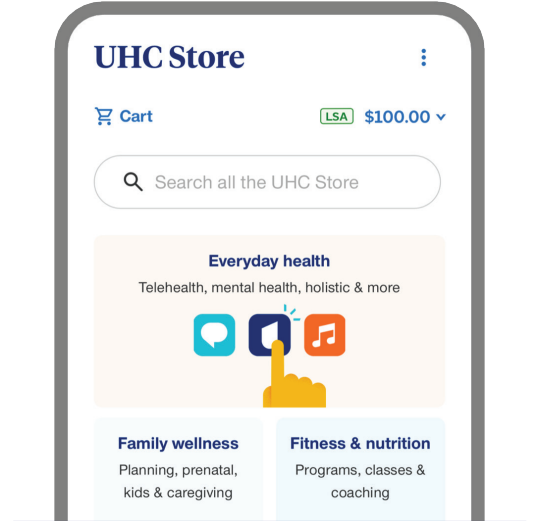
Funds can be used on general well-being products (non-213(d)-eligible expenses)
